AMENDMENT TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION FOR KERRIEFONTEIN AND DARLING PHASE 2 WIND FARM ON KERRIEFONTEIN 555/0 AND SLANGKOP 552/3 WITHIN THE SWARTLAND LOCAL MUNICIPALITY OF THE WEST COAST DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY IN THE WESTERN CAPE PROVINCE

The Department's decision on the above application issued on 02 November 2011 and your amendment application received on 11 November 2011 refers.

Based on a review of your motivation, the Department in terms of the powers vested in it by regulation 45 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2010, has decided to amend the environmental authorisation (EA) dated 02 November 2011 as follows:

1. The details of the applicant are hereby amended from:

"Oelsner Group (Pty) Ltd."

to:

"CK Darling IPP (PTY) Ltd."

2. The location of the activity on page 1 (cover page) is hereby amended from:

"Western Cape Province: in the Swartland Local Municipality on portion 0 of the farm Kerriefontein No. 555 and portion 3 of the farm Slangkop no. 552".

to:

"Western Cape Province: in the Swartland Local Municipality on portion 0 of the farm Kerriefontein no. 555, and portion 3 of the farm Slangkop no. 552".

3. The project description on page 3 of 19 is hereby amended from:

- for the proposed construction Kerriefontein and Darling Phase 2 wind farm on farm Kerriefontein no 55, portion 0 and farm Slangkop no. 552 in Malmesbury within Swartland Local Municipality of the West Coast District Municipality, Western Cape".

- for the construction of the Kerriefontein and Darling Phase 2 wind farm on portion 0 of the farm Kerriefontein no. 555 and portion 3 of the farm Slangkop no. 552 in Malmesbury within the Swartland Local Municipality of the West Coast District Municipality in the Western Cape Province, hereafter referred to as "the property".

This amendment must be read with the Environmental Authorisation issued on 02 November 2011.

An amended Construction EMP reflecting the above amendments must be submitted to this Department after the notification period for written approval before the commencement of the construction phase of the approved development.

In terms of regulation 10(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2010 (the Regulations), you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties, in writing and within 12 (twelve) days of the date of the amendment EA, of the Department's decision in respect of your amendment application as well as the provisions regarding the submission of appeals that are contained in the Regulations.

Your attention is drawn to Chapter 7 of the Regulations, which prescribes the appeal procedure to be followed. This procedure is summarised in the attached document. Kindly include a copy of this document with the letter of notification to interested and affected parties.

Should the applicant or any other party wish to appeal any aspect of the amendment decision a notice of intention to appeal must be lodged by all prospective appellants with the Minister, within 20 days of the date of the EA, by means of one of the following methods:

If the applicant wishes to lodge an appeal, it must also serve a copy of the notice of intention to appeal on all registered interested and affected parties as well as a notice indicating where, and for what period, the appeal submission will be available for inspection, should you intend to submit an appeal.

Please include the Department (*Attention: Director: Environmental Impact Evaluation*) in the list of interested and affected parties, notified through your notification letter to interested and affected parties, for record purposes.

The authorised activity/ies shall not commence within twenty (20) days of the date of signature of the authorisation. Further, please note that the Minister may, on receipt of appeals against the authorisation or conditions thereof suspend the authorisation pending the outcome of the appeals procedure.
